

Classic EQ by Kjaerhus Audio

Classic EQ is a 7 Band Stereo Equaliser with a warm analog sound, well suited to make non-surgical tonal corrections on all instruments, vocals and final mixes. The passive and additive structure, together with unique “Warm” and “Saturation” algorithms, produces warm and pleasant sound, just like some of the most expensive vintage gear. The left and right channels can be adjusted individually or linked together.

Features

- Seven band stereo equalization
- Separate left and right channel adjustments
- Warming and Saturation
- Stereo Link
- Presets
- VU meter
- Ultra low CPU usage
- Supports all sampling rates from 44100
- Full VST automation

Tips

1. Cut frequencies below the instruments’ fundamentals in order to get a cleaner sound with better definition.
2. Panorate your instruments by cutting a few dB from 2k – 20kHz in one channel and boost by the same amount in the other channel.

- Hyperlink from logo, quickly allowing a check for updates and new products.

- Solved issue where the GUI was invisible and / or wasn't repainted properly in some hosts and wrappers.
- Solved issue with wrongly reported I/O sampling rate.
- Solved issue where plug-in would report that no GUI was available when requested by the host. This caused one host to not open the GUI.
- Improved VU-meter updates.
